#### Admission to the Competition

The Frate Sole Foundation announces the 8th edition of the International Sacred Architecture Prize aimed at all designers who have completed a church within the last decade (since 2014) within the Christian denominations.

#### Award Objectives

The submitted works must convey expressive qualities of mystical values, harmony, and beauty of forms, originality, and creative strength in architectural conception, bestowing upon the building a heightened atmosphere of spirituality, an expression of courageous and passionately innovative research, free from any mannerism or conventionality.

#### Required submissions

For the submission of materials, please strictly adhere to the criteria outlined on the website <https://www.fondazionefratesole.org>, by filling out the competition registration form online.

#### Participation Method

Submission deadline: ~~Friday 24 May 2024~~

The materials must be submitted to the Frate Sole Foundation through a specific form to be filled out, which can be accessed from the Foundation's website within the set deadline. The documentation shall not be returned but shall be retained in the Foundation's archives, which reserves the right to exhibit the works, as well as to utilize the illustrative and graphic materials for publications, without any obligation to the designers.

#### Queries

#### Privacy

In pursuit of its institutional aims, 'Frate Sole' Foundation - as Data Controller - is very attentive to protecting natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data, working in compliance with applicable regulations, including through the preparation of technical and organizational measures. In order to proceed with the electronic submission of the application, participants are required to review the information provided pursuant to Article 13 et seq. of Regulation 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council (GDPR) and Legislative Decree 196/2003 and subsequent amendments and additions, available in the online form, consenting to the processing of personal data.

#### Evaluation

The documentation submitted by the candidates will be evaluated by the Jury, whose members will be announced on the website in April 2024. By 15 July 2024, Frate Sole Foundation will publish the competition results on its website. All admitted candidates will be notified and invited to attend the award ceremony in Pavia, scheduled for Saturday, October 5, 2024.

#### Award ceremony

The total amount of the International Prize for Sacred Architecture 2024 shall be **30,000.00 €**.

Participation in the event is a prerequisite for the awarding of the Prize. At the discretion of the Board of Directors of the Frate Sole Foundation, this amount may be awarded to a single winner, or divided among several winners. The first prize winner shall become, by right, a member of the Honorary Committee's award section of the Frate Sole Foundation, collaborating in future activities of the Foundation. The award ceremony will take place in Pavia on **5 October 2024**, according to a programme to be announced later. A documentary exhibition of all accepted works will be prepared on the day of the award ceremony.
